


Yerba Buena Nursery Lawn "Removal" Basic Steps



- 1. Remove unwanted shrubs/trees
- 2. Cap off existing sprinkler system underground
- 3. Optional: "Scalp" lawn mow as low as possible
- 4. Cut back edges of lawn, 4" deep and 12" in from edge
- 5. Create organic looking mounds with removed soil
- 6. Place two layers of uncoated brown sheet mulching paper¹ at right angles over the entire lawn
- 7. Place 4-6" layer of soil² over paper
- 8. Install plants (see transplanting instructions)³
- 9. If Applicable: Install drip lines
- 10. Mulch with 3" layer of wood chips⁴ or leaves
- 1: Uncoated brown sheet mulching paper is available at Lyngso Garden Materials in San Carlos. \$14.50 for a 35" x 166' roll.
- 2: Lyngso Garden Materials carries an excellent mix for natives under the name 'potting mix'. It is fast draining and not too rich for native species.
